

## **Plastics Industry Association Outlines Guidance for Recycled Plastic Food Packaging**

The Plastics Industry Association announced publication of a new policy document, which outlines guidance for recycled plastic food packaging. The document has been prepared over a period of two years, with key inputs from association's member companies. It is predicted to open supply chain collaboration for food-safe recycled materials.

The guidance document is being released in order to ensure that packaging is made with postconsumer resin and that it complies with several U.S. Food and Drug Administration ([FDA](#)) regulations related to food-contact materials (FCM).
